# Oakley's Coaches King of the Hill 2014 Rules of Competition 

- You must be a member of CMI
- You must enter all three hill climbs run by CMI (Collinsvale, Baskerville and the Domain)
- There are two sub categories;

1. King of the Italians
2. King of the Barbarians (non Italian car competitor who is a member of CMI)

Points for up to the first ten places in each class

| 1st | 10 points |
| :---: | :---: |
| 2nd | 9 points |
| 3rd | 8 points |
| 4th | 7 points |
| 5th | 6 points |
| 6th | 5 points |
| 7th | 4 points |
| 8th | 3 points |
| 9th | 2 points |
| 10th | 1 point |

Should there be a tie on a single event, then all first place winners on the day (in that sub category) will have their best four times compared. The competitor with the smallest difference between their times (ie, most consistent) will receive a bonus point in order to determine the winner for that round.

In the event of an overall tie, the competitor with the greatest margin in their class in the final round will receive a bonus point and will thus be declared the "winner" of King of the Hill or King of the Barbarians.

Time keepers at each round are deemed to be judges of fact and no correspondence will be entered into.
